The Annapolis Valley Regional School Board serves the public and believes that the image that employees and volunteers project is important to establishing and maintaining a positive, respectful, and safe environment in the schools and worksites as part of its mission. Employees and volunteers are expected to serve as a role model for the students with whom they work and as leaders in the community.

Employees and volunteers are expected to dress in a manner consistent with the nature of work performed and are also expected to observe good habits of grooming and personal hygiene at all times. The attire must be appropriate, clean, tidy, and respectful. Any personal dress practices or preferences that prove offensive to others must be avoided.

Employees and volunteers are also expected to observe good habits of grooming and personal hygiene at all times.

- The Director of Human Resources is responsible for the implementation, monitoring and revision of this policy.
- This policy will be monitored annually.
